HIGH SCHOOL SKATING TEAM COMPETITION SKILLS ASSESSMENT FORM



The Competition Skills Assessment form must be completed for team members who want to compete in the Team Maneuvers events at competitions. For the 2024-2025 season, the Team Maneuvers event will consist of 9 elements at 4 different competitive levels. The Competition Skills Assessment form will help the Team Advisors and coaches put together our competition team(s) for each competition. Please submit a completed assessment form to the High School Team Advisors.

Note: The skills assessment needs to be completed and signed by your primary coach.

Team Maneuvers General Event Parameters

- Team maneuver events consist of teams of <u>at least 2 athletes</u> with no one skater performing more than 5 of the total number of elements. Teams must attempt all listed elements in each category.
- > Each high school team may enter only one team in each competitive level (exceptions given for Cyber Challenge).
- > An athlete may only compete at one team maneuvers level per competition.
- Athletes may "skate up" but they may not compete on a team at a lower level than the highest Singles test they have passed. Beginner Team Maneuvers does not permit passing a test higher than Pre-Preliminary Singles or Skating Skills or Preliminary Dance test.
- > Teams will have the option to use one retry, per element category per team (1 Jump, 1 Spin, 1 Skating Skill Sequence).

Team Qualifications

- > Skaters must be a Full, Aspire or Associate member of the Murray Silver Blades FSC and have paid the HS Team Fees.
- Skaters are expected to be taking weekly private lessons and be accountable for working on <u>ALL</u> skills within their competitive team maneuvers level.
- Skaters must have a skills assessment rating from their coach showing competent or mastered in <u>at least 4 Skills</u> within the level they want to compete.
